Finances

We understand that finances are an ongoing and paramount concern for families, and our desire is to make private, Christian education accessible to everyone. We grow community at Hundred Acre where our families are known and loved, and because that is at the core of who we are, we are actively engaging our community in creative and innovative ways to break down financial barriers in order to support and come alongside our families.

That being said, the decision to pour into your kids through the intentional pursuit of Christian education is going to be costly; both personally and financially.

There is no way to mitigate the cost of that sacrifice, nor should there be.

It will be hard, and it will feel uncomfortable.

Additional Information

Mandatory Enrollment Fees:

The fees reserve a place for students at the Hundred Acre Academy. **Enrollment fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.** Enrollment fees also provide for resources in the area of curriculum, technology, online and emergency information access, and security.

Multi-Student Credit:

Hundred Acre offers 72 hours of volunteer shifts per month that could result in a maximum tuition scholarship each month of \$330. We also offer a community sponsorship program. **For these reasons, we do not offer multi-student discounts.**

Homeschool Students:

The Hundred Acre Academy will offer partial day admission to homeschooled students on a case by case basis. Application fee will be \$50. Enrollment fees vary by course offering. Tuition is prorated at 120% of enrolled student tuition. Applies only to certain classes and availability is limited.

Family Support:

We will be addressing tuition assistance in the following ways:

Community Sponsorship

Our community sponsorship program invites community members to actively partner with our families through ongoing, monthly donations accepted on behalf of individual students as tuition reduction.

- This program allows students to be matched with a community member who will sponsor \$100 a month of that student's tuition
- While Hundred Acre will actively pursue and solicit sponsors on behalf of our students, **all families** are encouraged to actively pursue a community sponsor on behalf of their child. This is an important role for each family to personally invest in! Community sponsors who *know your child* are the best people to engage in an ongoing relationship. **Once a community sponsor has been identified, the Hundred Acre Academy will take over the ongoing administration of that monthly contribution.**

Volunteer Shifts: COFFEE HOUSE

Our temporary home (the post office building on Main Street) will house a coffee shop and bakery for the community, run entirely by students with the support of parent volunteers. **Monthly tuition scholarships are available once volunteers have worked eight hours.**

- The coffee shop and bakery will be open Monday through Thursday from 3-5PM after school. Parents can sign up as a volunteer to serve for a weeklong shift at the coffee shop (supervising our student workers and selling coffee and bakery items) and receive a tuition scholarship of \$110 that month. This scholarship will appear on your monthly invoice as a reduction in tuition.

Volunteer Shifts: JANITORIAL

Our janitorial needs will be met exclusively by parent volunteers, in two hour shifts four days a week. **Monthly tuition scholarships are available once volunteers have worked eight hours.**

- The building (four classrooms + common areas) will be cleaned in volunteer shifts from 4-6pm four days a week (Monday through Thursday). Families can sign up as a volunteer to serve for a weeklong shift on the janitorial crew and receive a tuition scholarship of \$110 that month. This scholarship will appear on your monthly invoice as a reduction in tuition.

Volunteer Shifts: INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPORT

Instructional support is vital in our classrooms. To encourage and foster the partnership between home and school, we will be offering opportunities to volunteer as an instructional aide in classrooms for two hours a day, once a week. Volunteers will be asked to commit to a monthly volunteer schedule. **Monthly tuition scholarships are available at the end of the month, once volunteers have worked eight hours.**

- Parents can sign up as an instructional support volunteer one day a week for two hours (month long commitment) and receive a tuition scholarship of \$110 that month. This scholarship will appear on your monthly invoice as a reduction in tuition. **This is separate from a classroom volunteer.** Instructional support volunteers work directly with students.

Hundred Acre Foundation ADDITIONAL FINANCIAL OPPORTUNITIES

Resource Center: Extracurricular Classes

Do you have a hobby, skill or talent you'd be willing to share with our community? Do you sew, know a foreign language, or love to garden? Are you a middle or high school teacher who could offer instruction in core subject areas to older students? We have a place for you at Hundred Acre! We have a flex school schedule; meeting four days a week for classroom instruction with Friday being a flexible learning day. **On Fridays, our students will have the opportunity to take extracurricular courses and classes offered through our affiliated nonprofit resource center, The Hundred Acre Foundation.**

- Classes at the Foundation will be taught by parents and community members, hired as Independent Contractors who are responsible for creating their own syllabus and teaching their own courses and setting their own tuition. **The full tuition charged to students belongs to the independent contractor.** The Academy charges a small administration fee per class, paid by families, on top of the tuition charge. As an independent contractor, we advertise your class, enroll students, and provide a space for you to teach. *This is a great way to offset tuition while also offering an engaging and enriching experience to our school community!*
